What we are looking for in an instructor: positive attitude, good communication skills, friendly, upbeat, ethical, patience, and good riding skills with a desire to learn and to teach. If you have a genuine love for people and a love for the sport of motorcycling, we are looking for you. The best way to impress students and other riders is to leave your ego at home when you come to the track. No one likes a show off or an arrogant person. One of the benefits of teaching is a gracious amount of track time; however, racers that are looking for track time on our dime and treating the day as if they own the track are not the riders we are looking for. Egotism and arrogance are not allowed.

The ability to observe and communicate: While we are looking for someone with excellent skills, your ability to observe, interpret what a rider is doing and effectively communicate this back to the rider is essential. In other words, if you say to yourself, "I'm fast but I don't know why" then you won't be able to teach others. We will work with you to become a better instructor but you need to have an understanding of your own riding and how you have progressed to where you are. You will find that the more you teach, the more you will learn about yourself and your own riding. Everyone can always learn more. We are all students, even pro riders.

Benefits: Riders/racers that teach with Cornerspeed Riderschools receive tangible and intangible benefits. There are many benefits for working with Cornerspeed: track time, your hotel accommodations and lunch(es) are provided at each event. Discounts and sponsorship deals with our corporate sponsors as well as free products from some of our sponsors are other benefits. The number of dates to which you can commit and ride will reflect the amount of sponsorship benefits for which you will be eligible. Instructor positions at Cornerspeed are not salaried positions. Intangible benefits include the business and personal relationships that you will build, the improvements in your own riding and what many instructors find to be the most satisfying benefit is the personal reward of helping someone improve and learn.

Ambassadors for the sport: You are already an ambassador for the sport of motorcycle road racing. When people meet and speak with you, they develop an impression of the sport from this initial interaction. The old expression, "a first impression is a lasting impression" is very true. Once you become an instructor with Cornerspeed, you become an ambassador for Cornerspeed Riderschools. What you say and do carries weight. People will listen to what you say and watch what you do. It is important to keep this in mind. Riders that come to schools and trackdays have a genuine love of the sport and look up to us. They have read about many of our instructors in magazines or have seen them on television. That Cornerspeed student you speak with could be a good business contact or new friend in the future. That sport enthusiast rider that you speak with may own a string of stores and would like to sponsor a racer or racing team. How you conduct yourself on and off the track may very well determine if you get that big sponsorship deal you've been looking for.

About Cornerspeed: We are a school. We teach riders and racers. We are serious about safety. Being smooth is the one phrase you will hear over and over. And it is all about corner speed. Not late on the brakes or fast erratic riding but smooth fast corner speed. If you're looking to be an instructor because it's cool to say you're an instructor and you get lots of track time for your own benefit then maybe this isn't for you.

Additionally, to ensure the consistency and quality of the Cornerspeed school, you'll be required to sit in on classroom lectures throughout most of the year to ensure you're absolutely familiar with the curriculum and teaching style of Cornerspeed.
